- European Scholarship programme;
- For education, youth(work) and sport;
- Where?
EU countries + United Kingdom, Norway, Iceland, Turkey, Serbia, N-Macedonia, Liechtenstein
- Fixed amounts per country per day;
More or less between €600 and €3000 in total

YOU CAN APPLY FOR AN ERASMUS+ SCHOLARSHIP



- If you are going to study/do a full-time internship abroad within E+ countries;
- If you are going to live abroad as well;
- If you're studying abroad for at least 3 months;
- If you're doing a full-time internship abroad for at least 2 months;
- If the total number of days is less than 360 (incl. all activities during Bachelor)

YOU CAN NOT APPLY FOR AN ERASMUS+ SCHOLARSHIP



Erasmus+



- If you're going to Switzerland;
- If you'll be living in the Netherlands;
- If you're staying for less than 2/3 months;
- If you have already received a scholarship for 12 months during your Bachelor studies;
- If the total number of days will be more than 360 (incl. this application)

MOBILITY - ONLINE

- Apply on time in **Mobility Online**:
 - Deadline study Spring 2021 25/11/2020;
 - *Deadline* internship Spring 2021 09/12/2020;
 - Note: the deadline only applies to the 1st step;
 - Complete the other steps before the start.
- **Complete** your work-flow before the start of your study/internship abroad.

- Confirmation of survey invitation EC after return done (student)
- Confirmation of documents after return given (student)
- Scholarship granted & Second payment issued (fontys team study abroad)

Force Majeure (overmacht)



WHAT HAPPENS IN CASE OF UNFORSEEN CIRCUMSTANCES

- Red/Orange area or cancellation?
 - If you stay abroad and continue online = normal procedure, no need for repayment
 - If you go back home and can continue online your scholarship continues with Force Majeure procedure.
 - If you go back home and can't continue online your scholarship stops that date. You can claim expenses.
 - If you can't leave and it is cancelled beforehand. You can claim expenses.
- Yellow/Green, you choose to return?
 - Minimum duration = OK = normal procedure, no need for total repayment
 - Minimum duration = not OK = No Force Majeure, **total repayment needed**

Blended Mobility



Blended Mobility is an option, contact Study Abroad!

- Blended mobility is planned from the start, prior to start of your activity abroad and you have an email confirming this.
- First have virtual mobility, and afterwards physical mobility.
- The physical part (abroad) should have a minimum duration of 2 months (internship) and 3 months (study abroad).
- In case you don't make this, Force Majeure can still be applied.
- You only receive the Erasmus+ scholarship for the period you are actually abroad.

ERASMUS+ SCHOLARSHIP



Erasmus+

- Go to www.fontys.edu/studyabroad for indicative amounts (use the calculator) and conditions;
- Apply on time;
- 70% before start, 30% after end;
- Make sure all documents are signed and stamped;
- Not a native speaker? You must do an OLS test;
- Study Abroad tries to check all documents within 5 working days;
- Extra scholarships for students with special needs.

Extra grant options



- Students going to Germany also have the option to get the **DIA-Stipendium** scholarship. Only for Study Abroad.
- Going out of the EEA (European Economic Area) you might get the **Holland Scholarship**.
- Going abroad after your Fontys studies? **VSBfonds** grants has interesting opportunities for Fontys alumni.
