Are you ready to introduce your university and country in a fun and engaging way? We invite each participating university to create a 4-minute pitch presentation that will help us get to know each other better!

Your Mission

Create an engaging group presentation that showcases your university, your team, and your local culture. Think creative, fun, and interactive!

Presentation Requirements

Each university group should prepare a presentation containing:

About Your University (1 minute)

- Brief introduction to your university - location, size, and main focus areas
- Showcase one innovative student project that makes your university proud

Meet the Team (1 minute)

- Introduce your team members in a creative way
- Share why you're excited about international collaboration

Your Local Flavor (1 minute)

- Show us something typical for your home country or region. E.g.:
 - Present a typical local dish that others should try
 - Highlight a famous person from your region
 - Showcase a prominent IT/tech company from your area
 - ...

Interactive Elements (1 minute)

- End with a relevant or funny greeting or saying in your local language
- And 'pass the mic' to the next group by asking them a question about their country like:
 - "In the Netherlands, students cycle everywhere - rain or shine! Our bikes are our most prized possessions. What's the most common way for students to get around in your country?"
 - "In Germany, cash is still king - many shops and restaurants only accept cash payments, which often surprises visitors. How do people usually pay in your country?"
 - "In Spain, we have a tradition called 'La Tomatina' where we throw tomatoes at each other in a huge food fight festival. What's the most unusual food tradition in your country?"
 - ...

Technical Guidelines

- Maximum duration: 4 minutes
- Format: Slides (PowerPoint, Google Slides, etc.)
- Include visuals to support your story

Tips for Success

- Keep it dynamic - mix information with fun elements
- Practice to stay within the time limit
- Be creative in your team introduction
- Prepare an engaging question that sparks interaction
- Speak clearly and not too fast for our international audience
